RUMA 853/23: Archita House No.284: Stable Restoration

We are very happy to inform that the restoration works are almost finalised. Some works need to be done on the bathroom and bedrooms.

The following restoration works have been completed:

- Roof removal (tiles, sheets, rafters, beams)
- Removal of degraded plasters
- Dismantling of damaged brick masonry
- Internal excavation for lowering the level
- Roof reconstruction
- Roof insulation and panelling installed
- Consolidation of foundations with stone masonry
- Restoration of stable vaults made of brick masonry
- Restoration of exterior plasters
- Interior wall pointing
- Underfloor heating
- -Electrical installation
- Sewage
- -Water suply
- Panelling
- Flooring
- Woodwork (doors and windows)

We have planned to use during this summer the restored stable for the accommodation of our volunteers.

We need to continue and consolidate the Archita community, towards civic engagement and social inclusion especially for the 50% of Roma community.

During the summer holidays we are organising every year extracurricular activities for the children from Archita

We are happy that during this summer our volunteers will be able to stay in Archita.

We are trying to get the priest house buildings on the list of national monuments.

Every time, the members of the national commission asked for more documents.

Last week we have finally fulfilled all the commission's requirements and our file for the Bunesti priest house is at the National Institute.

We are hoping that it will not take more than 6 months until the Bunesti priest house will have the distinctive monument code.

In the same time we are trying to find possible grant opportunities for the restoration of this property.

Our architect's Cosmin Pavel and Cristina Constantin have offered to create the technical project for the Durutya-Ebner house in Sighisoara for free.


MET only had to pay for the studies made by the different specialists. The technical project is almost ready, and we have extended the project for the whole property.


